## Steelhead Rods

The most popular category of Spey Rods is the **Summer Steelhead/All Round**. These rods cast spey lines in the 6 and 7-weight sizes. If you are looking to give spey casting a try, choose one of these. Whether for Steelhead/Heavy Trout nymphing or traditional spey casting, a 6 or 7-weight spey rod is your ideal choice.

### ACR Summer Steelhead/All Round

#### 6-Weight Rods

- 1266-4 Explorer** 12'6" 6-weight four-piece. A rod that is comfortable on most Summer Steelhead water south of Canada. This Explorer Series rod comes with the appropriate floating line!
- 1296-4** 12'9" 6-weight four-piece. A medium-fast action, smooth casting 6-weight that is perfect with Scandinavian style heads.
- 1316-4** 13'1" 6-weight four-piece. A truly all round light Steelhead spey rod. Designed with input from Jeff Putnam—enough said.
- 1386-5** 13'8" 6-weight five-piece.  
A moderate/fast action rod. This rod can do it all.

#### 7-Weight Rods

- 1237-5** 12'3" 7-weight five-piece. A good sink-tip rod with Skagit heads.
- 1297-4** 12'9" 7-weight four-piece. The lightest 7-weight on the market! Throwing 425 grains, this rod shines in underhand casting. Well represented on the Rogue and Deschutes. This rod works!
- 1317-4 Explorer** 13'1" 7-weight four-piece. A wonderfully smooth seven—equally at home with shorthead speys, Scando-head, or Skagit lines. This Explorer Series rod comes with the appropriate floating line!
- 1337-4** 13'3" 7-weight four-piece.  
Just ask Gary about his 15 lb. Deschutes Steelhead on this rod!
- 1397-4** 13'9" 7-weight four-piece.  
If you could only own one spey rod, this might be it. In a word—perfect.
